The Issues

- Authorship credit for publications emanating from the group or members of the group
- Acknowledging KT ICE funding
- Engaging the 'KT ICE' in grant proposals

Authorship: International Committee of Medical Journal Editors

- Authorship credit should be based on:
 - 1) substantial intellectual contribution to conception, design, acquisition of data, analysis or interpretation of data
 - 2) drafting the article or revising it critically
 - 3) approving final draft

- Students, trainees, research staff should be included as authors if they meet the criteria
- honorary authorship not acceptable

Process

- Negotiate role of authors early
- Negotiate order of authors
 - by contribution

Group authorship

- “the group” as author
- (individual authors) for “the group”
 - group members meet the criteria for authorship
- (individual authors) and “the group”
 - group members are acknowledged
- (individual authors)
 - KT ICE acknowledged

Acknowledging ICE funding/support

- Publications resulting from seed funding
- Publications resulting from fellowships
- Publications resulting from new investigator support

Use of the KT ICE in grants

- KT ICE grant
- KT ICE as official collaborator
 - Between ICE meetings- submit request to the executive
 - At ICE meetings – discussion
 - PIs write KT ICE letter of support
- Investigator acknowledges membership in KT ICE
- - No request required

Proposed criteria for authorship

- Group authorship (no individual authors identified)
 - Papers directly generated out of discussion at ICE meetings (eg. methods or conceptual papers)
 - Papers generated from ICE research projects
 - Writing group may be identified
 - All members meet authorship criteria
- (Individual authors) *FOR* the KT ICE
 - KT ICE members must meet authorship criteria
 - Papers resulting from discussion at ICE or ICE projects

- (individual authors) *AND* “the group”
 - Involvement of most ICE members very minimal
 - We still consider the paper an ICE output
 - ICE group does not meet authorship criteria but are acknowledged in list

- Individual authors only
 - Papers may be related to ICE objectives
 - Minimal involvement of ICE members (at least 2)
 - KT ICE acknowledged
